



Leasing has officially begun at [18W55](#), and it's already making waves as one of the most exciting new addresses in Midtown Manhattan. Developed by the Wilf Family's [Skyline Developers](#) and designed by the ever-iconic [Morris Adjmi Architects](#), this ultra-luxury boutique tower rises 25 stories just off Fifth Avenue. It's not every day that a rental building feels like a high-end condominium, but 18W55 is rewriting the rules – offering the space, finishes, and style that New Yorkers usually only find in a for-sale property, all with the flexibility of leasing.

The building itself is a love letter to New York’s architectural heritage, but with a sleek, modern twist. Its limestone and bronze-toned metal façade takes inspiration from nearby landmarks like the Fifth Avenue Presbyterian Church and the Peninsula Hotel, while soaring window bays give it a fresh sense of rhythm and proportion. From the street, it feels both timeless and forward-thinking—exactly the balance Morris Adjmi is known for. As Adjmi himself put it: “At 18W55, we set out to create something extraordinary—a building that speaks the timeless language of Fifth Avenue while introducing a new chapter in refined rental living. Throughout the design process, our guiding principle was to translate the rhythm and texture of the city’s iconic architecture into a distinctly contemporary residential experience. It was an exercise in balance between past and present, elegance and ease, form and feeling. Every detail was considered to make daily life both beautiful and effortless.”

Inside, 97 residences ranging from studios to sprawling three-bedroom homes – plus several full-floor penthouses – show off that balance in every detail. Seventeen apartments even come with private terraces, a true Midtown rarity. Floor-to-ceiling windows frame dramatic city views, while interiors feel as sophisticated as they do livable, with warm white oak floors, lacquered cabinetry accented with brass pulls, and sleek, integrated appliances. Kitchens are finished with Cambria stone counters and backsplashes, while bathrooms are designed as spa-like retreats, with clean lines, soft finishes, and luxe fixtures that make even a Monday morning feel indulgent.

With over 10,000 square feet spread across multiple levels, residents can move effortlessly between a two-story fitness center, private cinema, golf simulator, entertainment lounge, and even a co-working suite designed for today's hybrid lifestyle. It's as much a social hub as it is a sanctuary, with bold design and high-tech touches throughout. Add in a 24-hour attended lobby, dog washing station, private storage, and lifestyle management by LIVunLtd, and daily life feels seamless from every angle.
